



Redundant IT equipment Policy

Aim: It is the policy of Oden Services UK Ltd to refurbish and reuse to prolong the life-cycle of as much equipment that is possible to minimise our impact on the environment and provide a positive return.

Oden Services UK Ltd don't just crush and recycle, we currently repair and refurbish 89% of all equipment we collect. This allows the equipment to be re used which extends the life cycle rather than it being destroyed. Having good quality second user equipment for re use has a significantly lower impact on the environment than recycling waste materials. The 11% that is beyond any further use is separated into it's respective waste streams and sent for raw material reclamation. All of which is licensed and overseen by the Environment agency.

As well as obvious environmental pluses this also addresses very important social issues. Refurbished equipment is resold and distributed to individuals that cannot always afford new equipment or will be donated to charity to further education. Our extensive service removes all redundant equipment. WEEE compliance, waste transfer notes, data wiping and full audit trail reporting.
